**St Erme Community Centre** TR4 9BD is located 4 miles north of the city of Truro and 2 miles from the A30. There is ample parking on site for 70 cars.

**From the A30:** continue towards Truro for approx 2 miles turn left in to Trispen at 'Rowes Honda' then immediately left and immediately right into 'Castle Field' .

**From Truro take the A39:** towards Bodmin after approx 4 miles you will reach the parish of St Erme take the second turning right into Trispen at 'Rowes Honda' then immediately left and immediately right into 'Castle Field'.
